Lone Mountain Ranch will hold its First Annual Full Blood Production Sale April 19, 2008



Sale Preparation Underway

With the anticipation of the First Annual Production Sale April 19, 2008, staff members and hired help have been putting in long hours under the New Mexico sun to construct the arena and viewing/holding pens for the future event.

The ground is broke, posts have been set and as the dust clears, the outline of sale pens and an arena

takes on a more realistic feel at Lone Mountain Cattle Company.

The sale promises to be the largest Full Blood Wagyu public auction in US history, with over 50 high quality, live animals available - including over 25 bulls, 7 cows (ready to flush), 10 heifers and 10 calves - plus embryos and pregnancies.

BR Fukutsuru 0620 is a son of Fukutsuru 068, the highest marbling bull in the 2006 US Wagyu Sire Summary. His maternal grand-sire is Michifuku - who received the **2nd highest REA EPD** in the same sire summary.

BR Fukutsuru 0620 has been assigned a BW EBV of -0.6 by the Australian Wagyu Association Breedplan, ranking him in the top 5% of LMR sires.

LMR Sires produced 78 calves in 2006 & the average birth weight was 60-62 pounds.

That's calving ease!

Also included in the sale: two 13-Star bulls, eight 12-Star bulls, two 11-Star bulls, and six 10-Star bulls – all ready to work... They include sons of Michifuku, JVP Fukutsuru 068, and Sanjirou.

Additionally, 2 JVP Fukutsuru 068 daughters (both ready to flush with calves by their side); 3 Sanjirou daughters ready to flush (all with calves by their side); and 6 Michifuku daughters (2 with calves by side & ready to flush; 3 confirmed bred).

Seven flush cows include: 1 sired by JVP Fukutsuru 068 and 3 by Michifuku - of the 7 mother cows, two 12-Stars and two others are 11-Star females.

Present plans call for 24 embryos and 10 pregnancies to be included in the initial Lone Mountain Full Blood Wagyu Production Sale to be conducted on the ranch property - April 19, 2008.



NEW 14-STAR BULL

LMR YOJIMBO

Lone Mountain Cattle Company is proud to announce that **LMR Yojimbo** has received the highest possible GeneSTAR ranking, posting 14-Stars. LMR Yojimbo is a Full Blood Wagyu yearling - bred, raised and owned by Lone Mountain.








The GeneSTAR report indicates that LMR Yojimbo has a combination of 14-Stars, testing homozygous for all four marbling gene markers and all three tenderness gene markers. LMR Yojimbo's pedigree is of the highest quality as are his GeneSTAR results— his grandsire, **JVP Fukutsuru 068** is the top marbling Wagyu bull according to the 2006 National Wagyu Sire Summary (EPD = +.70), compiled by Washington State University. His maternal great-grandsire, Yasufuku, is one of Japan's most highly regarded sires. **Michifuku** and **Takazakura** are also listed in Yojimbo's 3-generation pedigree.

LMR Yojimbo is one of three known bulls in the United States to earn a 14-Star ranking, which illustrates the superior genetics LMCC strives for in their herd.

LMCC also owns **Bar R 12P Takazakura**, which received a 14-Star status earlier this year. Unfortunately, he consumed a toxic plant, which resulted in kidney failure, leading to his death this summer.

We are please to offer both LMR Yojimbo and Bar R 12P Takazakura's superior genetics at Lone Mountain Cattle Company. With their outstanding GeneSTAR rankings and combined pedigrees and genetic profiles, these two bulls are elevating our genetic performance within the breed.
